RULES OF CERTIFICATION SUMMARY

Each animal is **only** eligible for the ABI Certified Angus Beef Program where its meet the following criteria:

- i. Is sired by a registered pedigree Aberdeen Angus (AA) Bull.
- ii. Has a passport that confirms the animal's breed as AA or AAX.
- iii. Animals sold for the ABI Certified Angus Beef Program must meet the Bord Bia Sustainable Beef & Lamb Assurance Scheme (SBLAS) residency requirements, (i.e. is resident on a Bord Bia certified farm (or farms) for a minimum of 70 days but may be more as specified by your processor to meet contract requirements).
- iv. The Producer is a signed-up member of the Angus Beef Ireland Producer Group.
- v. Passes the visual inspection to confirm Angus breed traits.

Please note the following additional information:

- All animals are visually inspected in the lairage for Angus traits.
- All AA animals are polled, but soft/scur horns are acceptable on AAX animals.
- Cattle will not be certified if they fail visual inspection.
- Animals must meet the processor/retailer's requirements.
